 - b. Currently conducting governance consultations Want to present high-level preliminary findings, take questions, and send out a survey
 - i. Graduate student feedback is very beneficial because we are the only people that are taking the surveys as both teacher and student
 - c. Online ACE evaluation participation has decreased over time
 - d. Four preliminary recommendations:
 - i. Revise "End-of-Course Student Ratings"
 - 1. Introduce university core items, fewer than 10 open-ended questions in total, using simple terms with low bias.
 - a. Examples of open-ended core questions:
 - i. "Would you recommend a course taught by this instructor?"
 - ii. "What aspects of the course were most useful for your learning?"
 - iii. "When this class is taught again, what changes would you suggest?"
 - b. Still looking for feedback on these and suggestions for others.
 - c. Want to keep questions short and less than 10 in number.
 - ii. Encourage ongoing student feedback
 - 1. Develop pool of formative assessment ratings and questions and share campus wide as ICON modules that TA's and instructors can use
 - iii. Promote systematic peer review
 - Propose polices for consistent use of peer review as part of P&T processes
 - iv. Offer comprehensive educational resources
 - 1. Conduct training programs for DEO and AD-faculty on multifaceted nature of teaching effectiveness

 - iii. College of Public Health has proposed to become a GPSG member government

 - c. Reason to leave is thus: From conversations amongst themselves they feel that they are professional students and their interests are better represented as such, under GPSG
