    - i. Highlights
      - 1. Recognizes the graduate college's role in effective teaching at UIowa.
      - 2. Recognizes the national leadership contributions of the Graduate College.
      - 3. The Graduate College is now supporting more graduate students than before, but they recognize the need to improve recruitment strategies.
      - 4. 65% of doctoral students completing their programs within 5 years
      - 5. Received a recommendation to improve the promotion of their vision for graduate student success. They are currently under resourced but working on the recommendation.

    - i. Under the proposed changes to Chapter 20, the only mandatory bargaining item would be base pay, but it places a cap on increases to base payat 3%. Hours of work, leave, benefits, tuition and fees would no longer be mandatory topics. Member dues prohibited and grievances would be prohibited topics.
    - ii. Designed to make it difficult to remain in a union.
      - Every two years have to have an election in order to keep certification of the union. Union have to foot the bill for elections. Would need half of the union to show up and vote yes.
